Good afternoon,

I need to apologize for myself and on behalf of the District for the situation around the Oversight Committee. I did fail to get all of the pieces in order to meet the deadline today. This was not a willful attempt to skirt our responsibility as the need for a COC is well known to us. I won't go into all of the factors that got us to this position, but instead reiterate that the committee will be formed as soon as possible. I take full responsibility for where we are now and will ensure that we will have a fully compliant and functioning COC as soon as possible.

I know that Gary Riddle is going to serve as the rep from the Tax Payers group. I have attached the application to get the necessary information we need from him. Please let me know if there are any questions regarding that.

I have publicized the opportunity for others to join the committee and am closing off the application period next Wednesday, March 22nd. I will be asking for the Board to meet the following day, March 23rd, in a special meeting to appoint the committee members. I will confirm those details with you when I have them.

Again, I apologize for this situation. I genuinely appreciated your input and working with you as we moved to placing Measure Q on the ballot and am disappointed that I allowed these circumstances to develop. I certainly do not want to provide you with reasons to be concerned with my or the District's commitment to handling Measure Q and its many components properly.

Dear Board of Trustees:

I am not sure if you are aware of numerous emails (below) that were exchanged between our Association and Superintendent Dolan in regards to the Bond Oversight Committee.

Ed Code 15278 (b) requires that this committee must be established "within 60 days of the date that the governing board enters the election results on its minutes." The board entered the election results on its minutes at the January 12, 2017, meeting thus this committee shall be established by March 13, 2017.

As you know Ed Code Section 15282 states that one member of this committee shall be a member of "a bona fide taxpayers' organization." Our member Gary Riddle has volunteered to serve on the committee. However, we haven't heard anything from the Dixon Unified. We hope the lack of communications in regards to our participation on this committee is because Superintendent Dolan is busy and not because the District is retaliating against SCTA for filing a complaint with the Fair Political Practices Commission. As I have stated in the past, we agreed to stay neutral and not campaign against Measure Q, we did not agree to look the other way when the laws are violated. Retaliation against our organization will not be in the best interest of the School District.
